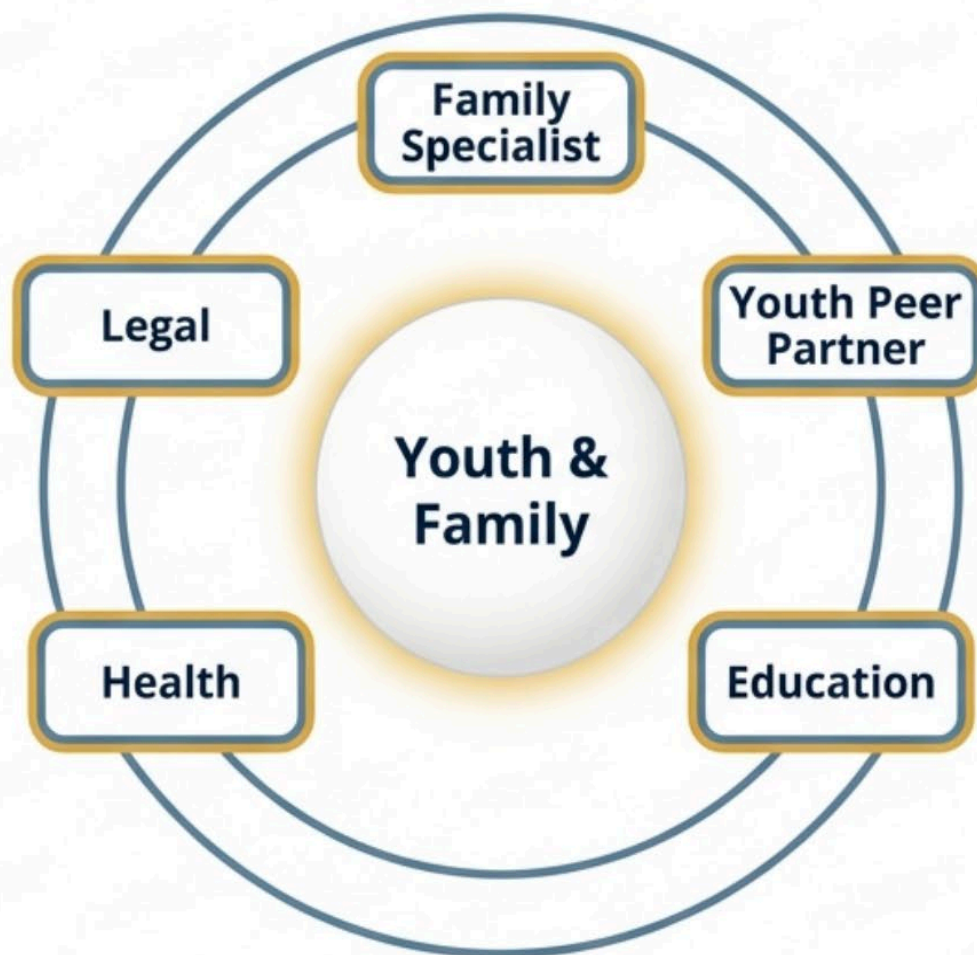

The Engine of Immediate Needs: High-Fidelity Wraparound (HFW)

The Model:

Immediate Needs (IN) is built on the California HFW model (ACL 25-47).



The Team-Based Model

Service Intensity Increases with Tiers

- **Tier 2:** Includes Family Specialist and Youth Peer Partner.
- **Tier 3+:** Enhanced ratios (1:2 Family Specialist), overnight in-home support, specialized family finding (1:20 ratio).



Immediate Needs Program Builds on Foundation of HFW

WIN aims to expand and increase intensity of services, increasing coordination to leverage what is available through existing systems, ensure accessibility for all youth with identified needs, and fill critical gaps when traditional funding streams are not available
