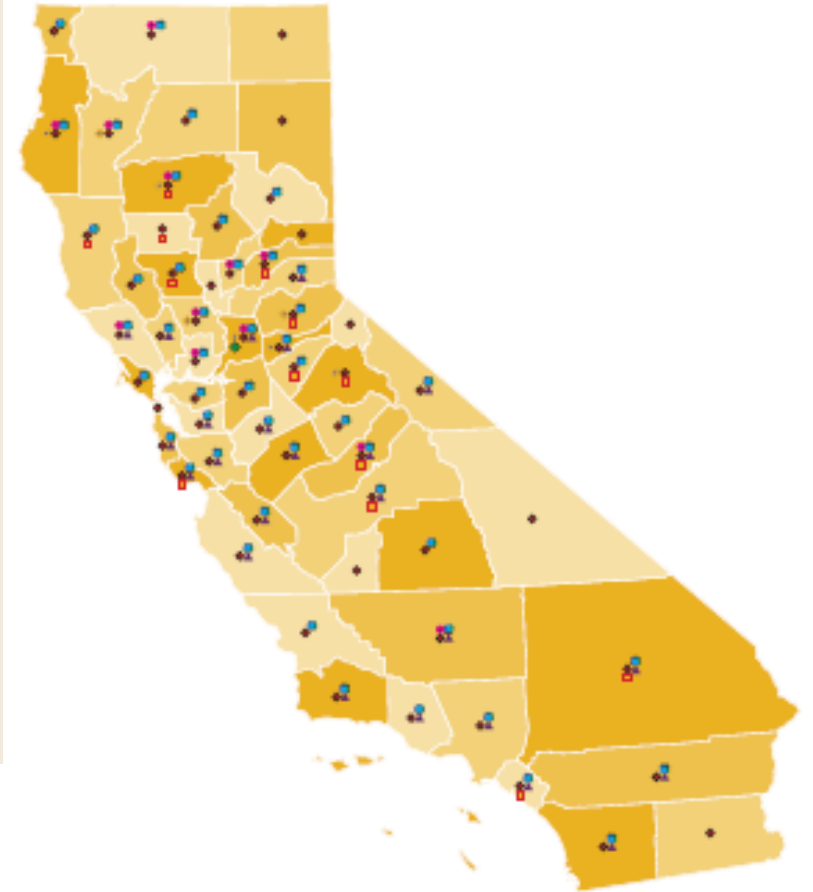
# THE OPPORTUNITY: CONNECTING TRS TO PREVENTION
