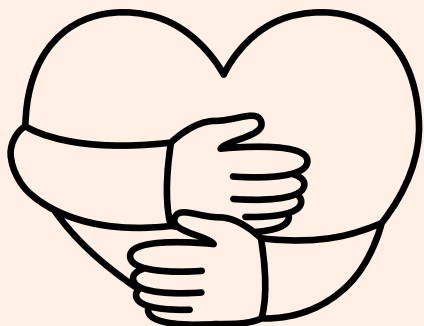
Explore Opportunities to Support Foster Youth in Your Community!
